

Our Survey

Following are the results of our August 31, 2007 Blair Road UMC Survey. A total of 245 people responded to our initial congregational survey. Following are some of the statistics gathered.

34.9% said they would feel somewhat comfortable talking with someone about their addiction problems.

61.4% said they didn't know where to go in the congregation to get help for someone with a drug, alcohol, or other addiction problem.

52% said they didn't know where to go in the community to get help for someone who has an alcohol, drug, or other addiction.

81.1% said they would support our congregation offering programs to raise awareness about addiction.

84.4% said they would support our congregation offering prevention strategies for drug and alcohol abuse.

87.3% said it was very important for the faith community to help those who have problems with alcohol or drugs.
